Anita Goodesigns – Pansies and Parasols CD

Read the first few pages of booklet to get an overall view of this project.

Select the design size that will fit your embroidery machine. These designs come in four different sizes. The largest size fit the 260x200 hoop for the Creative Vision or Diamond. Use your software to be sure the design fit your hoop.

Two pieces of cream or white cotton fabric cut to fit your embroidery hoop. These pieces will not show when block is completed. Press and starch these pieces.

Cut two pieces of Medium Tear-away stabilizer to fit your embroidery hoop.

Choose two colors of cotton or silk fabric. Be sure these are tone-on-tone or solid color. (no busy prints) I found 1 yard of each color made the 16 block quilt. If you just want to learn the techniques; just bring two pieces of each fabric that are 2 inches larger than complete block. Prepare as follows - Fuse JH Sheer Magic Plus to the wrong side of all the pieces. Be sure the interface is completely fused. Because of the time limit, the class will work one corner and one side block.

Use your software-and transfer one corner block and one side block that will fit your hoop to your memory stick or to sewing machine.

Embroidery hoop and embroidery foot (NEW Pfaff 200X200 will work great)

General sewing equipment- example power cord, reading glasses

Metallic Thread - Brother or Robison-Anton.

Thread stand

Small appliqué scissors – sharp and that can cut close to stitches

Rayon threads- 5 purples or any color in 5 shades for pansies and parasols

1 Rayon thread for beads (Stitches that cover the raw edges between the two fabric appliqué pieces)

1 Shades of green Rayon thread, 1 Cream Rayon Thread and 1 -Brown Rayon Thread
