

Supply List for Hobo Handbag classes: (See samples in classroom at Duval)

Basic sewing and embroidery supplies

Embroidery machine we will also use regular sewing functions when putting the bag together. Embroidery Foot, Regular Sewing Foot, Walking Foot, and Edge Stitching Foot.

Machine in good working order.

Manuel for machine.

Power cord, embroidery unit, foot pedal.

A few sheets of paper, and pencil for tracing bag pattern.

5X7 hoop for embroidery machine. "Snap Hoop" works well with this project but also can use regular 5X7 hoop. Can not be done with a smaller hoop.

Fabric:

¼ yd of 3 coordinating fabrics this is for the panel done with the embroidery machine. Fat Quarters work well)

1/3 yd of contrasting fabric for the top of the bag. I have up sized the pattern. If you also wish to do that then buy 1/2yd.

Before class sub cut fabric

6 pieces of fabric 6" Wide X 8" long for panels

4" Wide X 22" Long for handles

2/3 yd of fabric for the lining

1/4 yd of warm & natural for the panels.

Before class sub cut warm & natural 12 pieces 6" Wide X 8" Long

1/2 yd of fusible fleece

Before class sub cut fleece strip 1" Wide X 28" in Long. Remaining used for top of bag

For closure a ponytail elastic holder works well.

Decorative button for closure.

Embroidery supplies:

Embroidery thread of your choice to embellish panels

Bobbin thread for embroidery (prewounds can be used)

No Show Mesh for stabilizer

Basic embroidery supplies

Embroidery needle size 75/11

Sewing supplies for putting the bag together:

Universal sewing machine needle size 80/12

Regular sewing thread to sew bag together

Bobbin thread to match

When putting the bag together the Walking Foot is most helpful!

Rotary cutter

Scissors

Ruler for cutting fabric

Pins
