

Sampler Quilt #3 - Westalee Rulers

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Supply List

- Ruler Foot package from Westalee Design by Sew Steady. Package includes the Ruler Foot, 12" arc template, spacing gauge, and stable tape.
- Sampler Template Set 1 from Westalee Design by Sew Steady
- Extension table for your sewing machine
- Sew Slip Teflon sheet
- Cross Hair Square - Westalee Design by Sew Steady
- Prepare and mark the following quilt sandwiches. Mark the fabric without batting underneath. You may use scrap muslin and a low loft cotton batting. This is the center Block C of the Sampler Quilt
 - 1 26" quilt sandwich - See picture on next page
 - Using a fabric marker, draw a 24" square inside this sandwich
 - Draw a 12" square in the middle of the sandwich. Inside this 12" square, draw 2 diagonal lines from corner to corner and draw the vertical and horizontal lines as well. The Cross Hair Square is perfect for accomplishing this.
 - Lay the Cross Hair Square with its center over each corner of drawn 12" square. Draw the diagonal, horizontal, vertical lines.
 - Lay the Cross Hair Square with its center over the midpoint of each of the sides of the 12" square. Draw the diagonal, horizontal, vertical lines.
- Medium color Mettler Metrosene thread that will show on muslin. Wind a bobbin with this thread. You may use any thread your machine likes.
- 80/12 Microtex and/or 80/12 Denim and/or 90/14 Quilting and/or 90/14 Embroidery needles
- 8 Gb or more USB stick or external hard drive to receive videos of the class
- Basic sewing supplies like scissors, fabric marking pens, pins, etc.

If you would like me to supply a practice muslin quilt sandwich, please let me know several days ahead. The fee for the quilt sandwich is \$8, payable at class, cash or check.
