

Sampler Quilt #6 - Westalee Rulers

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Supply List

- ○ Ruler Foot package from Westalee Design by Sew Steady. Package includes the Ruler Foot, 12" arc template, spacing gauge, and stable tape.

- ○ Sampler Template Set 1 from Westalee Design by Sew Steady

- ○ Extension table for your sewing machine

- ○ Sew Slip Teflon sheet

- ○ Cross Hair Square - Westalee Design by Sew Steady

- ○ Prepare and mark the top fabric of the following quilt sandwiches. Mark the fabric without batting underneath. You may use scrap muslin and a low loft cotton batting. The block sizes are not the actual Block D Sampler Quilt sizes. These are for practice.

- ○ 3 - 16" square quilt sandwiches. Mark as follows:
- ○ Block 1 - Draw a 12" square in center. From 1 side of the 12" square, draw a vertical line, 3" in. Along that side of the square and the newly drawn line, make small marks at 3", 6", and 9". On the remaining 9"X12" section, draw the 2 diagonal lines and 1 vertical line (parallel to the 3" line)
- ○ Block 2 - Use cross hair square and mark center dot and the 8 lines
- ○ Block 3 - Use cross hair square and mark center dot and the 8 lines. Rotate the cross hair square and draw 8 more lines for a total of 16. Place a mark 7" from center on the main diagonal lines. Place a mark at 5 1/2" from center on the vertical and horizontal lines. Place a mark at 4" from center on all the other diagonal lines. See picture on next page

- ○ Medium color Mettler Metrosene thread that will show on muslin. Wind a bobbin with this thread. You may use any thread your machine likes.

- ○ 80/12 Microtex and/or 80/12 Denim and/or 90/14 Quilting and/or 90/14 Embroidery needles

- ○ 8 Gb or more USB stick or external hard drive to receive videos of the class

- ○ Basic sewing supplies like scissors, fabric marking pens, pins, etc.
