

# Sampler Quilt #7 - Westalee Rulers

## Supply List

- ○ Ruler Foot package from Westalee Design by Sew Steady. Package includes the Ruler Foot, 12" arc template, spacing gauge, and stable tape.
- ○ Sampler Template Set 1 from Westalee Design by Sew Steady
- ○ Extension table for your sewing machine
- ○ Sew Slip Teflon sheet
- ○ Cross Hair Square - Westalee Design by Sew Steady
- ○ Prepare and mark the top fabric of the following quilt sandwiches. Mark the fabric without batting underneath. You may use scrap muslin and a low loft cotton batting. The block sizes are not the actual Block D Sampler Quilt sizes. These are for practice.
  - ○ 4 quilt sandwiches. Mark as follows:
    - ○ Block 1 - 16" square - Draw a 12" square in center. Using the cross hair square, mark center and draw 8 lines. Rotate and draw additional 8 lines for total of 16. Connect the lines through the center dot. Draw a mark 5 1/2" from center on all lines. See picture on next page.
    - ○ Block 2 - 16" square - Same as Block 1 above except an additional mark at 3 3/4" from center on all lines. See picture on next page.
  - ○ Block 3 - 16" square - Draw a 12" square in center.
  - ○ Block 4 - 19" X 16" rectangle - Draw a 15" X 12" square in center. Draw diagonals from corner to corner. Do not use the cross hair square for this. On the horizontal and vertical lines, draw a mark 5 1/2" from center. On the diagonal lines, draw a mark 3 3/4" from the center. See picture on next page.
- ○ Medium color Mettler Metrosene thread that will show on muslin. Wind a bobbin with this thread. You may use any thread your machine likes.
- ○ 80/12 Microtex and/or 80/12 Denim and/or 90/14 Quilting and/or 90/14 Embroidery needles
- ○ 8 Gb or more USB stick or external hard drive to receive videos of the class
- ○ Basic sewing supplies like scissors, fabric marking pens, pins, etc.
