More ZIA on Your Sewing Machine

This class is normally scheduled on the 2nd Tues evening of the month. You may choose to draw tangle patterns and/or sew tangles using your sewing machine. We will explore new tangle patterns each month and revisit others. We sometimes will experiment with different sewing techniques such as using a twin needle.

<u>Supply List</u>

Supplies except fabric are available at Cathey's.

- Pigma Micron Pen Set (3pc) (Contains sizes 01, 03, and 05 pens)
- Zentangle tiles or watercolor paper or Zentangle Spinner (Project Pack #4)
- Zen Quilting Workbook
- 1 spool Sulky 30wt black thread
- Microtex 80 needles
- 1/2 yd Dyer's cloth or quality 100% white cotton fabric
- Water soluble marking pen
- Regular open toe foot for your machine (Not a free motion foot)
- Floriani No Show Mesh Fusible White Stabilizer (If you prefer, you can use a square each of Warm and Natural batting and muslin instead of the stabilizer)
- Scraps of tearaway stabilizer
- Black prewound bobbins or bobbin thread wound on a bobbin
- Basic sewing supplies like scissors, seam ripper, glass head pins, etc.
- Your sewing machine and its accessories

Preparation for ZIA on Your Sewing Machine

- Tear or cut the cotton fabric into 12" squares. Press and block on a gridded padded surface to "square" the fabric. Prepare 1 or 2 squares.
- Press No Show Mesh Fusible White Stabilizer to the back of the 12" fabric square
- If you are using batting instead of stabilizer then make a quilt sandwich by layering the cotton fabric, batting, and muslin. Use KK2000 spray adhesive to stick the layers together
- Thread machine with Sulky 30 wt black thread in needle and black bobbin thread in bobbin.
- Put new Microtex 80 needle in machine
