Supply List


- o Ruler Foot package from Westalee Design by Sew Steady. Package includes the Ruler Foot, 12" arc template, spacing gauge, and stable tape.
- o Sampler Template Set from Westalee Design by Sew Steady
- o Extension table for your sewing machine
- Grid Glider or Sew Slip Teflon sheet
- o 8 Point Cross Hair Square Westalee Design by Sew Steady
- O Prepare and mark the top fabric of the following quilt sandwiches. Mark the fabric without batting underneath. You may use scrap muslin and a low loft cotton batting. <u>The 16" square block sizes below are not the actual Block D Sampler Quilt sizes. These are for practice. For real size Block D, cut 16" X 19" quilt sandwiches. Mark Block 1-4 as follows.</u>
 - o 4 quilt sandwiches. Mark as follows:
 - Block 1-16" square Draw a 12" square in center. Using the cross hair square, mark center and draw 8 lines. Rotate and draw additional 8 lines for total of 16. Connect the lines through the center dot. Draw a mark 5 1/2" from center on all lines. See picture on next page.
 - O Block 2 16" square Same as Block 1 above except draw marks 3 3/4" from center on all lines. Do not need the 5 1/2" marks that are shown in the picture on the next page.
 - O Block 3 -16" square Draw a 12" square in center.
 - O Block 4 19" X 16" rectangle Draw a 15" X 12" square in center. Draw diagonals from corner to corner. Do not use the cross hair square for this. On the horizontal and vertical lines, draw a mark 5" from center. On the diagonal lines, draw a mark 3" from the center. See picture on next page. Ignore the 5 ½" in the picture.
- o Medium color Mettler Metrosene thread that will show on muslin. Wind a bobbin with this thread. You may use any thread your machine likes.
- 90/14 Quilting and/or 90/14 Topstitch needles and/or 80/12 Microtex and/or 80/12
 Denim. Janome machines should use Purple Tip needles
- 32 Gb or more USB stick or external hard drive to receive videos of the class
- o Basic sewing supplies like scissors, fabric marking pens, pins, etc.


If you would like me to supply a practice muslin quilt sandwich, please let me know several days ahead. The fee for the quilt sandwich is \$8, payable at class, cash only.
