<u>Scrappy Bag on the Serger</u> <u>Supply List</u>

This project can make two sizes of bags, a large and small. Supplies for both sizes are included below.

- * Serger that can complete an overlock stitch
- * Bosal In-R-Form Plus double-sided fusible foam stabilizer. Small bag needs a piece 26 inches x 20 inches. Large bag needs a piece 33 inches x 24 inches.
- * Decorative thread 50 wt. or thicker. Your serger can use up to an 8 wt thread with a size 90 needle. You can use solid colors or variegated. Examples:
 - Floriani 40wt. Embroidery thread
 - Wonderfil 30wt. Mirage thread
 - Madera 40wt. Aeroquilt thread
 - o Wonderfil 50 wt. Tutti thread
- * Maxi Lock All Purpose thread for loopers
- * Decorative thread for rolled hem for flowers
- Fabric scraps. Scraps should be only 1 to 1.5 inches wide:
 - Small bag needs enough scraps to make a panel that is approximately 21 inches long x 11 inches wide and another panel that is 18 long x 5 inches wide.
 - **Large bag** needs a panel that is 33 inches long by 20 inches wide and another panel that is 28 inches long by 5.5 inches wide.
- Lining fabric: Small bag 27 x 21; large bag 33 x 24.
- Fabric scraps for flowers: 8 squares 4 x 4 and 4 squares 5 x 5.
- Handle fabric: 2 pieces 2.5 inches by the WOF (width of fabric, 42-44 inches).
- Decorative buttons for the flowers.
- 50 inches of Clear Vinyl tubing. ½ inch outer diameter. You can get this at the hardware store and you will need 2 pieces that are 25 inches each.
- * Pins
- * Snippers
