

Class Title: Applique Techniques with Swan

Supplies:

- Petals on Point Pattern
- Sewing Machine capable of a buttonhole stitch
- 80/12 machine needles (I like a Microtex needle for this process)
- Small scissors suitable for appliqué *
- # Paper cutting scissors
- Hand Applique needles size #10 or #11 (I prefer John James Golden Glide)
- Comfortable thimble *
- Small travel iron *
- Small personal ironing surface is suggested but not required *
- Trolley needle (available from Swan for \$13 – will have examples in class)
- Liquid starch (not Best Press) I like Stay Flo mixed with water in a 1 parts starch -2 parts water ratio.
- Small paintbrush
- A washout marking tool and a chalk marking tool *
- Freezer paper ½ yd
- Threads to match fabric selection (choose cotton #50 wt. cotton threads for best results) *
- Optional item: Invisible Thread for our machine stitching option *

Fabric:

- 3 Coordinating Fat Quarters for Flowers, Flower centers, Flower stems, and added elements
- 1 yard of Background Fabric
