

## Class Title: Shape Shifter

### Basic Supplies:

- A sewing machine in good working order
- Rotary Cutter
- Quality piecing threads that coordinate with your fabric colors or are neutral with your color
- A Marking Tool (I suggest both a washout marking pen and a Chalk Marking tool)
- A quarter inch foot for your machine or a seam guide of your choice
- A ruler of 3" x 18" or of similar size
- A squaring ruler at least 8 ½" x 8 ½"
- Pins (I prefer Silk Pins)

### Fabric Supplies:

Fabric requirements for both quilt sizes are listed below. Smaller made with 6" blocks and Larger with 12" blocks.

#### Small Shape Shifter (46" x 58")

**Background:** 2 ½ yards

#### Brights

**Fabric 1** (light) ½ yard

**Fabric 2** (med light) ⅓ yard

**Fabric 3** (medium) ⅓ yard

**Fabric 4** (med dark) ½ yard

#### Accent Color

**Fabric 1** (light) ½ yard

**Fabric 2** (med light) ½ yard

**Fabric 3** (medium) ½ yard

**Fabric 4** (med dark) ¼ yard

#### Large Shape Shifter (88" x 112")

**Background** 5 ½ yards

#### Brights

**Fabric 1** (light) 1 ¼ yards

**Fabric 2** (med light) ¾ yard

**Fabric 3** (medium) 1 yard

**Fabric 4** (med dark) 1 yard

#### Accent Color

**Fabric 1** (light) 1 yard

**Fabric 2** (med light) 1 yard

**Fabric 3** (medium) ¾ yard

**Fabric 4** (med dark) ½ yard

**Inner Border is created from the leftovers of the accent color fabrics.**

**Outer Border Solid** 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  yards

3 yards

**O. B. Partially Pieced**  $\frac{2}{3}$  yard

2 yards

(This can be one of the colors and it will be enough for both the fabric and the border.)

**Binding**  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard

1 yard

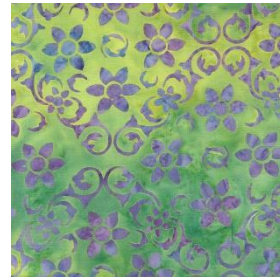

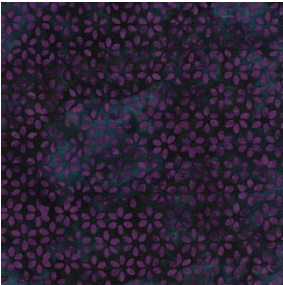
