

TEMPLEE QUILTING – REVERSE APPLIQUE

Supply List

- *Ruler Foot
- *Sampler Set Templates from Westalee Design by Sew Steady.
 - *2" Simple Circle
 - *6" Spiral
 - *4" Arc
- *Spacing Gauge

- *8 Point Crosshair Square
- *Extension table for your sewing machine
- *Grid Glider or Sew Slip Teflon sheet

Fabric and Batting Needs:

- 2 – 10" squares cotton solid-like fabric for top
- 2 – 10" squares cotton solid-like fabric that will show in reverse appliqué
- 1 – 10" square low loft batting
- *2 – 9.5" squares of double sided fusible web (Recommended - *Quilters Select Appli-Web Plus or Soft Fuse Premium Paperbacked Fusible Web)
- 2.5" X 50" binding if making hot pad

- *Contrasting machine quilting thread. Choose a color that will show but not too high contrast. Can use Madeira Aeroquilt or Mettler Metrosene or any thread your machine likes for free motion / ruler work.
- *Bobbin wound with the above machine quilting thread.

- *Appliqué scissors with sharp point (Gingher 6" Double Curved Appliqué Scissors)
- *90/14 Quilting and/or 90/14 Topstitch needles and/or 80/12 Microtex and/or 80/12 Denim. Janome machines should use Purple Tip needles
- *Fabric marking pen or chalk for marking reference lines (If white will show best on fabric, use Pen Style Chacoliner filled with Quilt Pounce. Ask Rose how)
- *Easy Threading needles (For burying thread tails)
- *12" see thru grid ruler
- *Basic sewing supplies like scissors, pins, sharp point seam ripper, basic machine accessories, etc.
