

Ruler Work for Beginners Supply List

- * Sampler Template Set and 12" Arc template. (Comes in the package for the Sew Steady ruler foot)
- *Ruler Foot (check with your machine brand as they may have one you can order) OR You can use the Sew Steady chart (ask the clerks at Cathey's for help) to determine your Domestic Machine Ruler foot size.
- *Sewing Machine in Clean and good working order; must be able to drop feed dogs.
- *Thread- Contrasting color so that you easily see your stitches. Fill a bobbin with same thread.
- Extension table for your machine.
- *Grid Glider or Sew Slip Teflon sheet
- 8 point Cross Hair Square 8" is okay but 12 ½" is best
- Fabric requirements: Total of 8 14"sq quilt sandwiches- it is best to practice with a non-pattered fabric any color is okay, this is practice for you, then you can go home and use your nice pretty fabric for your sampler quilt.
- Batting: one 14" sq per quilt sandwich we will try to get two designs done in each class.
- *Fabric Chalk or Iron off markers Dark and Light (I like the felt Frixion Markers- no shadows left.
- *Best press Spray starch
- *Sew Steady Spacing gauge
- Needles Topstitch 90/14; the Janome Purple needle makes any ruler work turn out well (just a suggestion)

Pen or Pencil and notebook to take notes if needed. I will have handouts for you.
