

EDGE-TO-EDGE QUILTING ON YOUR EMBROIDERY MACHINE Supply List

Your embroidery machine must have at least a 6" X 10" embroidery hoop to take this class.

- *<u>Edge-to-Edge Quilting on Your Embroidery Machine</u> book by Amelie Scott Designs
- 1 quilt sandwich using the following fabric requirements (Leave selvedge on fabric)
 (WOF means width of fabric)
 - o 1 yd X 42"-44" (WOF) solid or tone-on-tone cotton for quilt top
 - o 1 yd X 42"-44" (WOF) solid or tone-on-tone cotton for quilt backing
 - 1 yd X 42"-44" (WOF) batting Choose a thin (not lofty) batting such as
 *Floriani Quilters Select Soft Machine Batting, *Floriani Quilters Select Soft Cotton Batting, Warm and Natural Batting or bamboo batting
- *Floriani Cutaway Medium. Have enough for 2 hoopings. *Floriani's Tearaway or *Floriani No Show Mesh or *Floriani Power Mesh is ok
- *Quality thread that will show up well on the quilt top. Choose a brand of thread that your machine likes.
- 2 Bobbins wound with thread that will show on quilt back
- *Clover 1/2" Double Sided Basting Tape (No substitutions!) Do not need if using magnetic hoop
- Pen can be Ultra Fine line Sharpie
- *Fabric marking pen
- *Topstitch 90 and/or *Embroidery 90 and/or 75 needles
- *Optional: Magnetic or SNAP hoop in the largest size embroidery field your machine does
- *Basic sewing and embroidery supplies including your machine's embroidery unit, largest hoop and parts (ie. Good fabric scissors, seam ripper, pins, etc.)

PRIOR TO CLASS

- Read Easy-Connect Overview in Edge-to-Edge Quilting on Your Embroidery Machine book to familiarize yourself with the process.
- Have quilt sandwich prepared.
- Download the designs per the directions in the book. Load the design that you want to stitch onto your USB stick or load directly into your sewing machine. Choose the largest size that your machine's largest hoop will hold. Be sure to load both the A and B designs and ensure that they are both the same size!
