Embroidery Part 2 – Advanced Embroidery Supply List

- * Embroidery machine with hoops and the parts required to do embroidery i.e., embroidery module, power cord, embroidery foot, embroidery needles, and bobbin thread.
- * Embroidery & regular scissors.
- * Thread and fabric to go with your projects
- * You will bring a small In-the-Hoop project, examples are as follows from embroideryonline.com.
 - OESD Design #82033-02L, #82033-06L, #82033-10L, or #82033-14L or similar project. All designs are from the Share Joy CD and can be purchased as a single design.
- You will bring a Free-Standing Lace Design. No larger than a bookmark or a small Christmas ornament, because these designs take the longest to stitch out.
 - o Good examples are: Ombre Feather Bookmark #12635-03, design #12758, or #12715-02.
- You will bring a design that requires you to do applique. Some fun appliques are putting a design on a T-shirt, Sweatshirt or OESD tea towels just to name a few.
 - Examples are an OESD design #12653 Floral Alphabet Appliques, design#12392-01 Doddle
 Applique Flowers 1 Glitz or design #80060-08 Snowman 1 Applique.

Note: All the designs listed above are just suggestions, but what you bring need to be very similar to complete the projects during class.

Note: You MUST print and bring the instructions for the in the hoop project you select, you will need them to complete your project.

Note: Depending on your machine, there will be designs for you to use.

Note: I will supply all stabilizer for your projects – but you must bring your thread & fabric to match your design.
