

## **MORE ZIA ON YOUR SEWING MACHINE** **Supply List**

This class is normally scheduled on the 2nd Tues evening of the month. You may choose to draw tangle patterns and/or sew tangles using your sewing machine. We will explore new tangle patterns each month and revisit others. We sometimes will experiment with different drawing and sewing techniques .

### **Supply List for Sewing**

- \*1 spool Mettler Metrosene polyester black thread or Sulky 30wt black thread
- \*Microtex 80 or 90 needles
- ½ yd quality 100% white cotton fabric
- \*Water soluble marking pen or other marking pen that will disappear from fabric
- \*Regular open toe foot for your machine (Not a free motion foot)
- \*Floriani Fusible Power Mesh or Floriani No Show Mesh Fusible White Stabilizer (If you prefer, you can use a square each of Warm and Natural batting and muslin instead of the stabilizer)
- \*Tearaway stabilizer scraps
- \*Black prewound bobbins or black bobbin thread wound on a bobbin
- \*Pigma Micron Pen Set (3pc) (Contains sizes 01, 03, and 05 pens)
- Fabrico (Cool Gray) and Identipen (Black) ( Supplied in ZIA on Your Sewing Machine class)
- \*Your sewing machine and its accessories

### **Supply List for Drawing**

- \*Pigma Micron Pen Set (3pc) (Contains sizes 01, 03, and 05 pens)
- Kit supplied in Intro to Zentangle® class
- Zentangle® tiles or watercolor paper

### **Preparation for ZIA on Your Sewing Machine**

- Cut 1 or 2, 12" squares of white cotton fabric.
- Lightly fuse/press Fusible Mesh White Stabilizer to the back of the 12" fabric square
- If you are using batting instead of stabilizer then make a quilt sandwich by layering the cotton fabric, batting, and muslin. Use KK2000 spray adhesive to stick the layers together
- Thread machine with black threads, top and bobbin.
- Put new Microtex 80 needle in machine
